Sister Agnes, Principal Law, School Managers, Sisters, Teachers, Students, Parents, and Ladies & Gentlemen,

Thank you for inviting me to attend this great celebration of yours. I feel very honored to be able to address you all at my Alma Mater. I am also very touched to stand in this hall, which is named after my late mother - Maria Chu. Without my mother, I would not have studied at St. Francis', let alone standing here today.

I would, first of all, congratulate all the graduates. Today is your important milestone in life. I was in the same position as yours but it was 46 years ago. I left school then, but St. Francis' has never left my heart. I would say, I owe everything to St. Francis'. Besides learning all the academic knowledge, St. Francis' trained me to be a all-rounded person. My school never stressed on getting good grades per se. Rather St. Francis' concentrated on character development & a strong moral foundation. It also encouraged participation in all sorts of extra-curricular activities. And most importantly, St. Francis' was able to arouse our interests to learn. This is extremely important because we developed a sense of curiosity & take learning as a life-long process. We grew up in a nurturing environment. I am very lucky that St. Francis' has shaped my value system, and my outlook in life. Good seeds were planted in my heart and they became wisdom as I sail through life. I shall be forever grateful.

So today, with your indulgence, I would like to take the liberty of offering some advice on the things I learnt and I used to handle difficult situations all these years with my life.

First & foremost, stick to our motto - live by the truth in love. I have always drawn strength from this motto in times of need. As I said, I left school 46 years ago but I always remember our school motto. It has offered me a great sense of empowerment. When you are in doubt - follow our motto: In a nutshell, live by the truth in love means that you have to be true to yourselves and others. Accept painful truth with a loving heart. If you are able to share difficult truth with a humble, patient, kind, and loving manner & with the intention of doing good to yourselves and others, you won't be far too wrong.



The second thing that I would like to mention is - Facing challenges. I can ensure you that life is not going to be rosy all the time. You may fail, you may be ill, you may commit mistakes & have setback in career. You may be betrayed; you may have family problem. Challenges are gifts from God so that we can learn, reflect, and grow. Your character will be defined by how you react to challenges and the decision you make. Hardship can make us humble. Think, for a moment, what life would be, without challenges. Life without challenges is not a good life at all, nor a sweet dream come true. Would we ever make any progress without challenges? Would we ever improve? Would we ever experience the joy of overcoming hardships? In short, challenges help us to become better people.

The third principle I stick to is maintaining hope. Whatever circumstances you find yourself in, do not lose hope, even at the most desperate of moments. Be humble enough to seek help when it is needed. When you feel hopeless, just look around and appreciate the wonders of existence. The complexity of life in all its forms and the miracles in every living being. Our mind and body are so complicated that even scientists, up to today, cannot grasp how our brain works exactly. Sit back and observe – and you will see beautiful things around you. Have faith in God that you are a loving child of God & things will become better. There will be light at the end of the tunnel.

The fourth word for today is Gratefulness - A grateful heart is a blessed heart. Although you are still young, you must have met a lot of people who have helped you along the way. Have you ever thanked your parents for all the sacrifice they make? All the sweats and tears they shed in order to bring you up? Your teachers who educated you? The drivers who drove you to school everyday? And your Alma Mater which helped your character development and moral judgement? A grateful heart is also a happy heart.

The fifth thing I want to mention is – stick to your principles. When you step into society, there will be lots of distractions & temptations. Try not to be distracted. Please stay focused on your principles. Do not be tempted by selfish motivations or materialistic gain. Your integrity is sacred! Nothing can be traded for your most valuable integrity.





The last and the most important thing is Kindness. I learned from all the teachers and sisters about Kindness, through their examples. I'd share with you a personal experience at SFCC. I was a primary 5 pupil and our headmister, Sister Tsim came to me one day and asked me if I could give free tutorial to a P.I pupil whose parents were illiterate and could not help with her schoolwork.

This was my first volunteer job. I remember we sat on the store benches in our upper playground everyday before school assembly and I helped this little girl with her homework. Looking back, I can now understand why I am happy to be of help to others. In fact, having kindness is the greatest gift for the one who is kind and who gives. As our Lord said – the least you do to your brothers, you do unto me!

Finally, I would like to conclude by mentioning happiness. You will be happy only if you can develop your potential to the full and have a simple life. Do not judge your self-worth based on how the materialistic world defines success. Trying to reach other's materialistic expectation is the main source of unhappiness. Do not succumb to this worldly trap. Choose a career that you are passionate about. So I hope you try to stick to all these i.e. – stick to our school motto when you sail through life. Be brave when you face challenges & maintain hope. Resist temptation and be grateful and be kind & loving all the time.
